

Preparations for a Flea Treatment

Pre-Treatment

- Plan to be out for a minimum of six hours.
- Anyone pregnant, children two or under and anyone with any health concerns should remain out for twenty-four hours.
- Pets should remain out of the unit for a minimum of six hours. Fish tanks should be covered with a damp towel and the air filter and pump disconnected.
- Floors should be clear.
- Remove all items from the kitchen counters. Items can be put in the cupboards or in the bathtub.
- Move furniture and other items a minimum of one foot away from all walls.
- Remove items on the floor in closets. These items may be put on the bed in that room.
- The floors should be vacuumed and the bag thrown out.

Post-Treatment

- Ventilate upon re-entry to the treated area by opening windows and doors.
- Counters and Kitchen tables should be wiped with soap and water.
- Vacuum floors **3 days** after treatment and dispose of the bag.
