



## Pesticide Use Advice & Precautions

Pesticides can be harmful if caution is not used. It is advised that all persons remain away from areas treated with a pesticide until such time as the pesticide has fully dried. This time shall be denoted as the RE-ENTRY TIME.

As a precaution those with respiratory or cardiac ailments, pregnant women, the elderly, and those under the age of two years old should remain out of the treated area for a minimum of 24 hours after a pesticide has been applied.
